

ASBESTOS WASTE DISPOSAL RECORD

Bruce Rock Landfill Site

IMPORTANT

Prior arrangements must be made with the Shire or authorised landfill contractor before asbestos waste is delivered.

All asbestos waste must:

- ✓ Be double wrapped or double bagged in 200-micron thick plastic.
 - ✓ Be sealed with tape at all joints and openings.
 - ✓ Be clearly labelled "CAUTION – ASBESTOS".
 - ✓ Be transported and disposed of in accordance with applicable legislation and codes of practice.
 - ✓ Be placed only in the designated asbestos disposal area as directed by landfill staff UNDER STRICT SUPERVISION ONLY.
- Only asbestos waste generated within the local government district of Bruce Rock can be accepted at the Landfill Site.
 - Where pallets are used to support an asbestos load, these can be disposed of with the asbestos waste.
 - Failure to dispose in the approved location without prior approval by the Shire of Bruce Rock will result in the person responsible being invoiced for the cost of removing the waste.
 - It is preferred that asbestos is delivered for disposal during the landfill's normal opening days. Deliveries outside these times will incur additional charges.
 - Disposal during opening hours is also recommended to ensure that, if required, the Shire's landfill loader forks are available to safely remove asbestos from the delivery vehicle.
 - Where assistance is required to unload asbestos, the Shire may be able to provide this service on a cost-recovery basis. Any request for assistance must be approved in advance by the Manager of Works and Services and is subject to staff and equipment availability.
